Additional fees for Select/Junior A are payable by separate cheque and will be collected at the first tryout or may be paid by separate cheque at registration (Select only). This is a non-negotiable requirement. Cheques will be held in trust until player selection. Only successful player's cheques will be cashed. All others will be destroyed.

- Yes, I want to play **Goal** (Association provides, free of charge, chest/arm pads, shin guards and stick). Registration fee all divisions is \$150.

All equipment supplied by the Association shall be returned in good condition at season's end. Equipment not returned or returned in poor condition shall be the responsibility of the parents/guardian and subject to replacement at Association cost price.

**Refund Policy:** All fees must be paid before a player will be permitted to practice or play. Refund of registration fees will not be considered after March 30<sup>th</sup> except for valid medical reasons, up to and including the 4<sup>th</sup> game of the season, in which case a pro-rated refund will apply. A medical certificate will be required. A \$50 administration fee is applied to all refunds. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**Registration Process:** Please make cheques payable to DARTMOUTH BANDITS LACROSSE and mail your completed and signed registration, the signed liability waiver and code of conduct forms, the \$75 jersey deposit and registration fee to the address at the top of this page or deliver to one of the Open Registrations (dates at top of this page).

**Team Placement:** Space is not guaranteed and player spots are filled on a first come, first served basis. Registration is only official after **all registration requirements are fulfilled.**

**Family Discounts:** First player pays regular price, additional players each receive a \$25 discount. This does not apply if one of the players is a Goalie or if the player is a Pre-Tyke or Master.

**Jersey Deposit:** A separate \$75 cheque postdated for October 15, 2010 must accompany each registration to be held in security until the jersey is returned. If not returned by this date, cheque will be cashed.

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

**For Participants Under the Age of Majority in Nova Scotia**, the Parent/Guardian MUST read and understand this waiver prior to the Minor participating in Athletic activities. Indicate acceptance by signing the waiver where indicated.

### **WARNING: THIS AGREEMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS. READ IT CAREFULLY!**

The following waiver of all claims, release from all liability, assumption of all risk and other terms of this agreement are entered into by me on behalf of the Minor Participant (the "Minor") with and for the benefit of Dartmouth Minor Lacrosse Association, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, coaches, officials, business operators, agents and site property owners or Occupiers (the "Organization"). Occupiers is defined in accordance with the definition of Occupiers contained in the Occupiers Liability legislation applicable to the Province or Territory in which the Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization. Canadian Lacrosse Association/Lacrosse Nova Scotia, Metro Minor Lacrosse league are the governing agents of the organization and are responsible for the enforcement of the rules of play, discipline conduct certification and administrative policies.

1. I am the Parent/Guardian of the Minor and am executing this waiver on behalf of the Minor in my capacity as Parent/Guardian and with the intent that this waiver be binding on myself and the Minor for all legal purposes.
2. "Athletic Activities" includes but is not limited to contact and non-contact sports, fitness activities, personal training instruction and activities, use of facilities, and fitness programs and services provided to the Minor by the Organization.
3. I am aware that there are inherent and significant risks ("Risks") associated with the participation in Athletic Activities. I am aware that those Risks include but are not limited to the potential for serious personal injury caused by any event or any condition of the facility or equipment where Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization, and health risks such as transient light-headedness, fainting abnormal blood pressure, chest discomfort muscle cramps or soreness, and nausea I understand the Risks are relative to the Minors state of fitness and health (physical, mental and emotional), and to the awareness, care and skill with which the Minor conducts him or herself while participating in Athletic Activities.
4. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all Risk and possibilities of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from the Minor's participation in Athletic Activities. I agree that although the Organization has taken steps to reduce the Risks and increase safety of the Athletic Activities, it is not possible for the Organization to make the Athletic Activities completely safe. I accept those Risks and free to the terms of this waiver even if the Organization is found to be negligent or in breach of any duty of care or any obligation to me or the Minor in the Minor's participation in Athletic Activities.
5. I acknowledge on behalf of the Minor the Minor's obligation to immediately inform the nearest employee or others of the Organization if he or she feels any pain, discomfort, fatigue, or other symptoms that he or she may suffer during and immediately after his or her participation in Athletic Activities. I understand that the Minor may stop participation at any time, and he or she may be requested to stop by an employee or others of the Organization who observes any symptoms of distress or abnormal response.
6. In addition to consideration given to the Organization for the Minor's participation in Athletic Activities, I and my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns, as well as the Minor and his or her heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns (collectively our "Legal Representatives"), agree:
  - a- to waive all claims that I or the Minor have or may have in the future against the Organization;
  - b, to release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, death, property damage, or loss resulting from the Minor's participation in the Fitness Activities due to any cause, including but not limited to negligence (failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances), breach of any duty imposed by law, breach of contract or mistake or error of judgment of the Organizations; and
  - c. to be liable for and to hold harmless and indemnify the Organization form all actions, proceedings, claim, damages, costs demands including court costs and costs on a solicitor and own client basis, and liabilities of whatsoever nature of any kind arising out of or in any way connected with the Minor's participation in Athletic Activities.
7. I agree that this waiver and all terms contained within are governed exclusively by the laws of the Province or Territory of Canada in which the Athletic Activities are provided to me by the Organization. I hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that Province or Territory. Any litigation to enforce this waiver must be instituted in the Province or Territory in which the Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization.
8. I confirm that I have had sufficient time to read and understand each term of this waiver in its entirety, and have agreed to the terms freely and voluntarily. I understand that this waiver is binding on myself as Parent/Guardian, the Minor and our Legal representatives.

## **PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT.**

10. I will not use profanity, nor will I harass players, coaches, officials, or other spectators.

12. I will not force my child to participate in lacrosse.

## **PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. I will follow the rules of FAIR PLAY: I will respect the rules of the game, I will respect my opponents, I will respect the officials and their decisions, everyone will participate, and I will maintain my self-control at all times.
2. On game day, all players shall be in the dressing room at least 30 minutes prior to game time. Players shall be fully dressed and ready to go at least 15 minutes prior to game time. This period will be necessary to discuss team strategies and game plans. If you require more time to dress, come earlier.
3. On practice day, players shall be in the dressing room at least 20 minutes prior to practice time.
4. Players shall participate in every game and every practice except for illness, injury, or school events. If a player must miss a game or practice, he/she must contact the team manager or coach as soon as possible.
5. School shall take precedence over Lacrosse.
6. Foul language towards teammates, coaches, officials, or opponents will not be tolerated.
7. Players shall not be critical of teammates and never discuss teammates abilities except to encourage good team play.
8. Hot-dogging will not be tolerated.
9. Players are responsible for their own equipment and will ensure it is complete, safe, and in good condition at all times.
10. Each player shall use his/her own water bottle.
11. Lacrosse is a team sport. I am on a team and will be a team player.
12. Winning isn't everything. Doing my best in all games and practices IS everything.
13. I will respect all my teammates and my competitors.
14. If I score a goal I will thank my line-mates for helping me score the goal. If we get scored on when I am on the floor, I will encourage my goalie and try harder to help him next time.
15. I will listen to my coaches' instructions.
16. Each Player represents the game of lacrosse, the lacrosse association, and their team. Players shall conduct themselves in a dignified manner at all times, especially on 'the road'.
